Amendments and Supplements to the Competition Rules

(fixed in the IPC Handbook Section V, Chapter 6)

valid from January 1, 2001

1. Tempi of Dances

2. Number of Couples on the Dance Floor

A maximum eight (8) couples is allowed on the dance floor at one time, depending on circumstances the number can be increased by the WDSC.

3. Participation of dancers

A dancer can start only with one partner at Official Championships, Regional Championships and IPC Approved Competitions, even if these Championships and Competitions are divided in Standard and Latin-American Sections and two classes.

4. Competition Dress

IPC-WDSC will mainly follow the current rules for competition dress laid down by International Dance Sport Federation (IDSF). Exception from this rule will be dress and suit for wheelchair user.

The Technical Delegate has the right to disqualify any couple at the competition not dressed according to this rule.

5. Marking in the Final

Closed or Open Marking can be used in the final of Official IPC Competitions and Regional Championships.
