Eligibility:	<p>Couples For combi dance: A dance couple must consist of one male and one female partner. One of them has to be a wheelchair user. The dancer in the wheelchair has to have a minimum disability. The standing dancers must be an able-bodied dancer. For duo dance: A dance couple must consist of one male and one female partner. Both of them have to be wheelchair user and both dancers have to have a minimum disability.</p> <p>Medical conditions in accordance with IPC Wheelchair Dance Sport rules To be eligible for selection by an NPC for the 2010 IPC Wheelchair Dance Sport World Championships dancers must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • hold an active IPC Wheelchair Dance Sport license for the 2010 Season; and • have a "New" (N), "Review" (R) or "Confirmed" (C) sport class status. <p>NPCs can enter a maximum of three (3) eligible couples per event per class. In case of sport class change during the Classification process the NPC must not have more than three (3) couples per event per class.</p>

Time Limit:	A minimum of one and a half minutes for waltz, tango, slow foxtrot, quickstep, and minimum of one minute for Viennese waltz. A minimum of one and a half minutes for samba, cha-cha-cha, rumba, paso doble and minimum of one minute for jive.
Dance Floor:	A minimum of 250 m ² .
International Classification Process and Panels:	Athletes who will be classified need to bring with them Medical Information in English during classification and IPC WDS medical form. The International classification panels will be appointed by IPC WDS.
Classification Schedule:	Classification will be held on Friday, 5 th and Saturday 6 th of November by the IPC WDS Classification Team. Detailed schedule will be offered after the deadline of the final entries.
Doping:	Doping is forbidden in accordance with IPC rules and regulations (see IPC Handbook Section 2, Chapter 1.2)
Adjudicators:	7 or more international adjudicators from different countries; 1 non-voting Chairman of the Adjudicators.
Entry:	All entry forms must be signed by the NPC President or Secretary General and have to be received by Organizing Committee and IPC Wheelchair Dance Sport by fax or mail not later than the 1st July 2010 for the First Entry Form (Document 05) and the 3rd September 2010 for the Final Entry Form (Document 07+08).
Photograph:	For the accreditation is a passport photograph needed. It must be available to 3rd September 2010 . It can be send per mail (in high definition) or per post, then we will scan it.
Liability:	The organizer is not liable for personal injuries or damage to property. Each NPC is responsible for health insurance of each member of their delegation.
